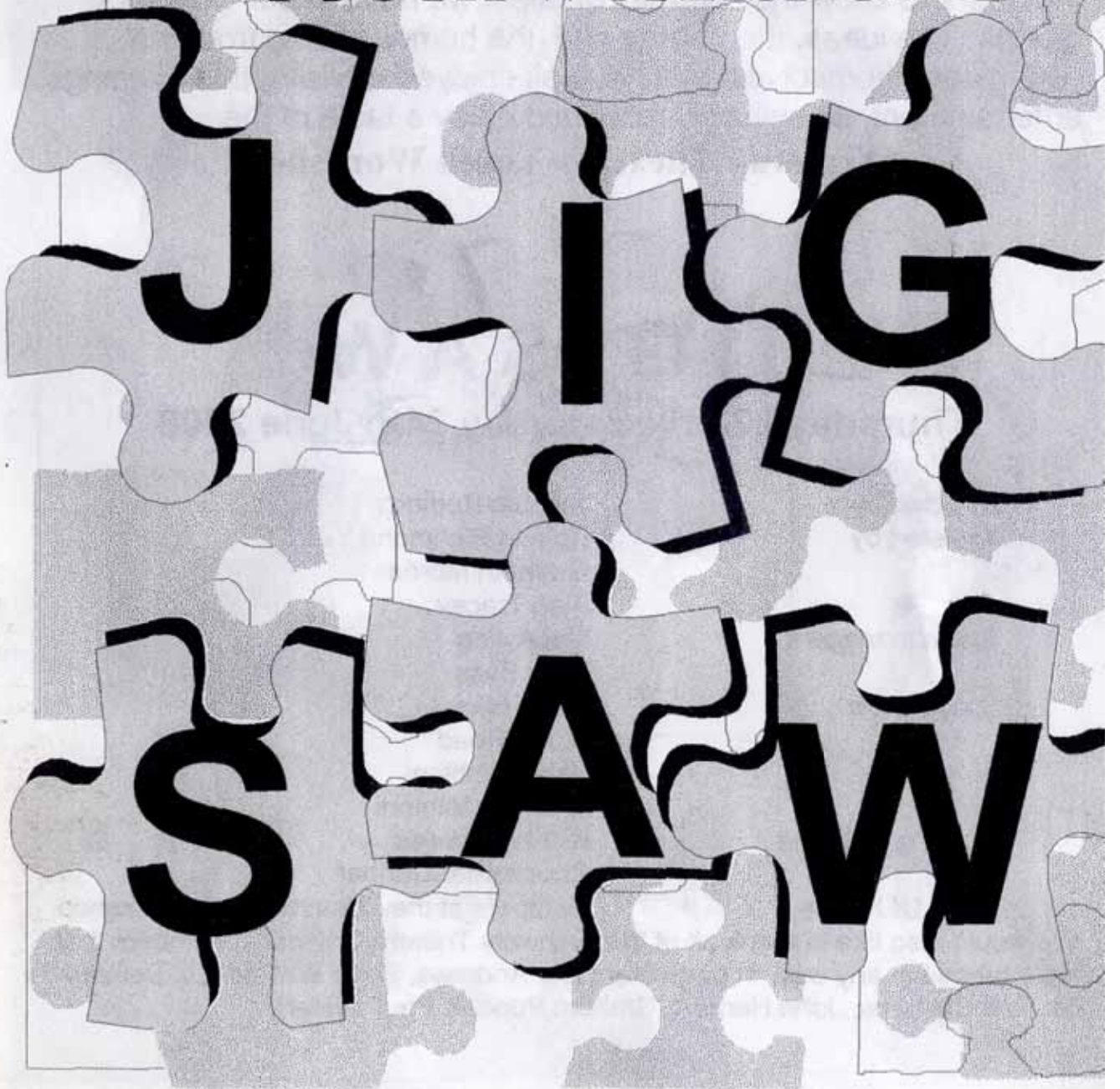

### Archway Theatre Youth & Junior Workshops:

5 years ago Eddie & Jacquie Redfern with Gwyneth Morris took over the running of the Youth Workshop. It then had 15 members attending one session every fortnight. Now there are over 80 active members ranging from 9 years to 16 years old, with three sessions being run fortnightly on Saturdays. For the Juniors, 6yrs to 8 yrs old, there is a regular weekly Wednesday session where we have a regular 20 members..... and we still have a waiting list for all groups.....we must be doing something right!

The youngsters come to workshops for a variety of reasons; they want to perform, they enjoy school drama, their parents suggest they come! They are not all confident extroverts, many prefer not to be centre stage but enjoy the social side, the activities and fun we have during our sessions. Our aim is not to create 'stars' but to enable each child to develop their own confidence, social and other skills, through games, activities and improvisation.

We try to cover all aspects of theatre. If in experiencing this they gain the enjoyment of the Archway Theatre environment and become actively engaged in a hobby that spans time, place and the age gap, then for us that is an added bonus which the Theatre and its patrons can share with us.
